THANK YOU

Thank you very much for the warm welcome we received when we were home visiting at the end of last term. Thank you also for the return of home school booklets and the new information about your child sheets. The 'Hopes, Dreams and Wishes' ribbons look lovely with many parents sharing similar aspirations. The children are beginning to settle into the nursery routines really well.

COATS AND SHOES

Please make sure your child has a coat in school each day for outdoor play. Our weather is so changeable that it can turn cold and windy in a short space of time. It is a good idea to put your child's name inside their coat. Mittens are much easier for young children to put on by themselves so consider buying these rather than gloves when the colder weather comes. If you spend five minutes sewing these to a length of elastic/ribbon and putting this through the sleeves of your child's coat, they will not get lost. Several children are wearing shoes with laces, please provide shoes with velcro rather than laces for nursery. On one occasion in the past, a child's undone shoe lace became entangled round a bike wheel and the lace had to be cut off to free their foot.

WATER BOTTLES

All children may bring a named water bottle in and leave it accessible on the trays provided. Please explain to your child that if they get thirsty during the session they are allowed to go and have a drink from their water bottle. The bottle must only contain water.

BOOK WALLETS/PAINTINGS

Please check you child's white box each day for any newsletters/paintings etc Due to limited space can all green book wallets go home at the beginning of each session. It is lovely to see older siblings but due to space and safety can we please ask that they wait outdoors. Please can all prams be left outside to ensure the fire door is kept clear.
