Our established and well respected programme provides high quality primary teacher training that is school-led and heavily school-centred.

Applications are processed through the UCAS Teacher Training website.

Our course can be searched using provider code 1X8, course code 2DFY.

Our course is a tuition fee route and successful applicants will be expected to pay fees of £9000. There are a number of different funding options available to support you with these payments.

Benefits of School Based Training:

- 3 terms (September-July) training, leading to the award of Qualified Teacher Status (QTS)
- You will be based mainly in school, with taught sessions led by outstanding current practitioners delivered mostly at our training centre;
- 2 masters-level modules, taught by our University colleagues leading to the award of a PGCE;
- Substantial teaching blocks in 2 contrasting local schools;
- High quality school-based mentoring.



- All of our successful trainees are able to access our NQT programme free of charge during their first year of teaching, and also have the opportunity to accrue additional masters credits during their NQT year if they choose to.
