Come and See

Our topics are; Local church- Journeys, Eucharist-Listening, and Lent-Sharing and Giving All. As always we encourage children to bring things in from home to support our learning. The children will also be leading the Ash Wednesday service.

English

This term we will be analysing stories from other cultures and poetry.

Mathematics

Geometry
Multiplication and division facts
Measuring in centimetres, grams, kilograms, litres and millilitres.

Science

This term we will investigate and experiment with Forces and Magnets. Please encourage your children to discuss their findings to develop their scientific vocabulary.

Topic themes to be covered

1. Stories from other cultures

2. Geography – Locality study of Crosby

The children will study the land use of Crosby both past and present. They will also develop their mapping skills.
